

PIERRE-LOUIS TOUTAIN

Emeritus Professor of Physiology and Therapeutics at the National Veterinary School of Toulouse, Pr Toutain is currently Visiting Professor in Veterinary Pharmacology at the Royal veterinary college, University of London, UK. Pr Toutain received his Veterinary Degree from National Veterinary School of Toulouse, Master degree in Statistics and PhD in Pharmacology from National Polytechnic Institute of Toulouse. He has been president of European College of Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology (ECVPT) and of the French Commission of marketing agreement; he was Deputy Chairman of Department of Animal Health at the French National Institute for Agronomical Research (INRA). He is currently the president of the European Association of Veterinary Pharmacology & Toxicology (EAVPT).

Pr Toutain's main research interests are Pharmacokinetics and pharmacodynamics of veterinary drugs (antibiotics, NSAIDs, endectocides, corticoids) and of endocrine disruptors ; his field of expertise is Pharmacokinetics/pharmacodynamics and population Modeling. Prof. Toutain is a member of the steering committee of the recently established VetCAST working group, under the umbrella of EUCAST

Pr. Toutain has presented about 150 communications to scientific congresses, is author [and co-author of 350 research articles](#) and director of 20 Ph.
